Our mission for the month of March will be in support of the work of Literacy Volunteers of Rensselaer County.

Through our donations Literacy Volunteers can provide tutoring in Reading/Basic Literacy and in English as a Second Language to approximately 250 teens and adults. A new program has been added as well, the Literacy Study Circle that provides literacy support for those students on the waiting list for a tutor. All these services are provided at no cost to their students by a staff and trained volunteers.
